

Commemoration Service at St Paul's Cobbitty and Wivenhoe Family Reunion and Picnic Day

Wivenhoe Historic House, 229 Macquarie Grove Road, Cobbitty

Sunday 23 August 2009

(Wivenhoe is situated in the grounds of Mater Dei Estate, cnr Kirkham Lane and Macquarie Grove Road, and is just a few minutes' drive from Camden or Narellan)

To conclude our week of Cowper200 celebrations, we have arranged a Commemoration Service at St Paul's Cobbitty together with a family reunion and picnic day on Sunday 23 August at the magnificent *Wivenhoe* homestead.

Wivenhoe, built on land originally granted to William by Governor Macquarie in 1812 by his son Charles, was home to the latter and his family between 1837 and 1875.

The day will commence with a family commemoration service at St Pauls Cobbitty at 9.30am. (St Paul's is located on Cobbitty Road, off The Northern Road from Narellan).

Following the service, take the short drive to *Wivenhoe* to renew old family friendships and meet new relatives. Explore the historical homestead and stables and learn more about Charles Cowper's involvement in the Camden area from members of the Camden Historical Society.

Enjoy your own picnic lunch and refreshments in the beautiful grounds or purchase from the Lions Club BBQ offering a selection of BBQ items. Morning and afternoon tea is also available for purchase during the day.

A small charge (\$10 per person 12 years and over) is payable to cover costs of hiring a marquee, chairs and tables.
